

First Steps to Solving Neuroma Pain

- ➔ Wear wider shoes. Shoes that are too narrow put additional pressure on the nerve and cause more pain to occur. Find the widest shoe that still stays on your foot
- ➔ Anti-inflammatory medication, such as Advil, Motrin, and Aleve, are great in managing this type of pain. Topical anti-inflammatories, such as Biofreeze, are also helpful.
- ➔ When it comes to pain such as this, ice is your friend, not heat. Ice serves as a natural anti-inflammatory. Apply it for 15-20 minutes at a time.
- ➔ Ladies, I know you hate to hear this, but lower your heel height. A high heeled shoe forces more pressure on the ball of your foot, right where the pain is.



What Is That Pain in the Ball of My Foot?

A common pain that people come into the office concerned about is a pain, often burning, numb, and tingling, in the ball of the foot and into the toes. The most common cause of this discomfort is a Morton’s Neuroma.

A Morton’s Neuroma is a swelling of the nerve that travels between the metatarsal bones. Although it most commonly affects the third and fourth toes, it can occur between any of them. Check out the sidebar to learn about what you can do first to stop the pain.

More advanced treatment for a Morton’s Neuroma may include prescription anti-inflammatory medication or cortisone injections. Custom orthotics help to redistribute the pressure away from the Neuroma. More advanced injections of an alcohol solution can actually shrink the Neuroma. Resistant cases, however, will often require surgery to resolve the problem.

As always, treatment will be most effective when sought quickly. Don’t wait for the pain to interfere with your lifestyle!

Product of the Month:

Formula 3

While it is true that the gold standard for treating fungal nails is an oral antifungal, such as Lamisil, it is important to realize that taking an oral medication is not for everyone and is often made more effective by adding a topical treatment as well.

Since most of the organisms that cause nail fungus reside underneath the nail, applying medication to the top of the nail is an effort in futility unless there is a transport system that will take the medication down through the nail. **Formula 3** has such a mechanism. It is an oil based solution which allows the medication to penetrate through the nail unlike other over the counter preparations which are either water or alcohol based.

Formula 3 is applied twice a day with the included brush. It is best to then rub the liquid into the affected nails with your fingers. There is no prolonged drying time nor do the nails have to be covered, so you can go about your business immediately.
